LSU is extremely proud to announce the Tiger Transfer Scholarship, a new merit-based scholarship for entering transfer students. Award amounts range from \$3,000 to \$1,000 per year for students who qualify. Award recipients must have a 3.5 academic GPA and at least 30 college-level transferable credit hours earned. Tiger Transfer Scholarships will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis for the fall semester only. Students should apply for admission and submit all requested documentation before April 15 to receive priority consideration.
